Also listed is his wife Rosanna, age 42, born in KY and his children Ellen, 12, Cecelia, 10, Maria, 8, and Emma 6, all born in IL. Also listed is Joseph Gregory, 24, born in Ohio a farm laborer. Daniel was a private in the BH War with the Odd BN Mtd Rangers. (This is how it is listed in the Illinois Veterans book that I have. I don't know what war it is referring to.) Nancy, I don't have much information on Lurany Reynolds, daughter of Mariah Manion and Willis Reynolds. I have her date of birth as 5 August 1849, I am not certain of my source for the exact date; however, I find her listed in the 1850 Hart County, Census as "Susanny" (sic) Reynolds, age 10, female, in household #459 headed by Willis Reynolds.

In the 1860 census she again appears in Willis and Mariah's household #217. In the 1850 census she is the fourth child. In 1860 two of her older brothers are gone and she is now the second child. Based on these two censuses, Mariah and Willis had ten children.

I don't have any information on her husband or children. I do have a picture of "Lou" Reynolds from her later days. My great aunt, Ailene Walters, granddaughter of Mary Elizabeth Reynolds, Willis and Mariah's fifth child, gave me the picture. I believe she was given this picture by Maxie Cobble whose mother was Emeline Reynolds, m. Powell Cobble. Emeline was the baby of this group of ten siblings. If you'd like, I will be glad to share this picture if I can find it and get it scanned. I would appreciate a list of her children if you have it.
